### June Meeting Minutes

Jimmy Monsour made a motion to make sure that the club pays the DJ at least \$25 plus whatever is in the tip jar. The motion was seconded and it passed unanimously.

Dennis Johnson then wanted to know why FASA can't budget for the DJ again since we now have some money. Chris Jestes said that we don't want to go and start spending our money already. Dennis then replied that he wanted to know what was budgeted before. James then said that we don't want to spend our money already.

The birthdays for June were read by Eric Rowe and they were invited to come up for the Birthday Dance after the meeting is adjourned.

There was a motion to adjourn the meeting and it was seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
