## March Meeting Minutes

The FASA General Meeting was held March 14, 2006 at the Elk's Lodge. The meeting was called to order by Steve Miller, President.

- Steve Miller Motioned to accept minutes of Feb meeting as they are in Newsletter. Motion accepted.
- Motion made by Bill Sessoms to correct Jan. '06 Minutes to reflect his motion in Jan '06 to read: Remove the clause, the whole paragraph, the hold harmless clause, in its entirety off the Membership application. Motion voted and accepted.
- Ron Pearsall Motioned to accept treasurer's report. Chris Jestes 2nd the Motion. Treasurer's report accepted.
- Patricia Rowland, Terry Barns, Joel Smith, and Paula Horn voted in as new members of FASA.
- Eddie Monsour to join FASA By-law Committee consisting of Head Joan Sessoms with Kathi Baloyot, Dwayne Baggett, Dennis Johnson, Dwight Vinson. Joyce Ramos will type results of study.
- **Membership** - Pat Trujillo filling in for Dwight Vinson has current membership at 135 with paperwork being completed on incoming new members.
- **Ways and Means** - Dwayne has SOS cards. **Hospitality, Entertainment, and Phone Tree** - No report.
- March Newsletter went out. A couple of corrections on dates will be reflected on next newsletter. Dennis Johnson will take care of.
- FASA Newsletters are sent out Bulk rate. FASA has to mail 200 to meet this criteria for cheaper Bulk rate price. Besides FASA members, Newsletters are also sent to Life Time Members, and other Shag clubs. FASA tries to mail only one Newsletter per household. See Rachel Dixon or Dennis Johnson if you didn't receive Newsletter. Appreciation expressed to Rachel Dixon for folding, taping, making inserts, and getting March Newsletter out in a very timely fashion.
- FASA has paid for the Postal License for the year. Anonymous donation is paying for printing of Newsletter for the year. It is costing approximately \$65 for monthly Newsletter mailing. The Newsletter will be an item for discussion at next Board Meeting.
- Steve Miller brought the Shag Book back from the ACSC Workshop for FASA members to sign. A scholarship is being (\$25,000 already raised) established in Phil Sawyers name. The book will be returned during SOS and be put on E-Bay for sale. The regular price of box is \$60. It has sold on E-Bay from \$400-\$500.
- Have not met with Don Rigsbee, new head of Elk's Lodge, yet. We may change some of the schedule.
- **Corrections to the Newsletter** - Next General Meeting is April 4, 2006; next Party April 8, 2006.
- **Correction to Website** - Website has potluck party in April; not the case. Potluck party to be in July. Chris Jestes will correct the Website.
- Eddie Monsour picked up the FASA sign from Dale Starns, the new owner of the former Cocktails and Memories.
- Dale Starns cannot offer FASA Friday or Saturday night for Hall of Fame Party due to this being his busiest nights. He could offer us a Monday, Tuesday or a Wednesday. Elk's Lodge isn't large enough for Hall of Fame Party. Eddie Monsour has ask for FASA help in finding a location for June 17, 2006 Hall of Fame Party. He will notify Al Cain. Discussion followed. Eddie Monsour willing to absorb food cost for the Party (approximate \$1,000 to \$1,5000). All discussion of Party at Shriners Club not feasible due to nonavailability. Eddie Monsour ask if he could approach Dale Starns with offer of giving him \$500 and bar profits for a Saturday night, not to exceed \$650. Motion made by Jimmie Monsour to investigate the location and find the price for the Hall of Fame Party and bring the results back to Membership. Bill Sessoms 2nd the Motion. Motion accepted. Jimmie Monsour Motioned to amend the price set for the Hall of Fame Party to \$500 for rental cost of location. Motion had a 2nd, vote was taken - 32 agree and 3 opposed. Motion carries
- Motion made by Beverly Beard to hold June 17, 2006 party at Elk's Lodge as it is written in the contract. Motion 2nd by Tom Hobgood. Motion was not accepted.
- The Board and full membership voted to replace computer in September. There has been a struggle with the computer for three years.
- Motion made by Mike Blanton to have a 4 year maintenance agreement for computer which covers parts and labor at \$189. Motion passed by majority vote.
- Bill Sessoms, in making reference to By-laws, highly suggested any expenditure of \$500 or over be brought before the Membership. Steve Miller, President, promised he wouldn't spend anything without talking to somebody.
- **Calendar of Events** - March 18 - St. Patrick's Party, April 4 - next General Meeting, April 8 - Party, April 21 - 30 SOS Myrtle Beach, SC, and May 9 - General Meeting.
- There are 19 new perspective members.
- Birthdays for March introduced and invited to come up for the Birthday Dance.
- Motion to close the Meeting **unanimously** accepted with **overwhelming** approval. Dancing began **finally!!**

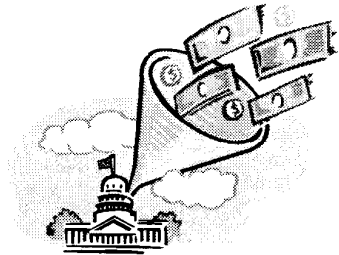
