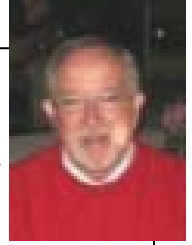

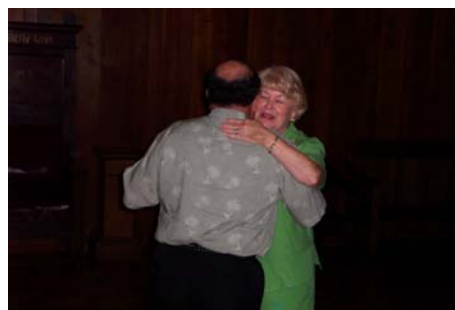

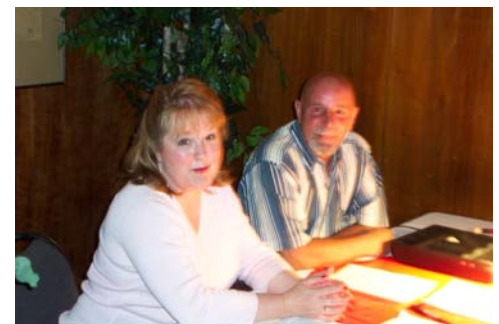
From the President
